### DITMAC CAPABILITY

*The DoD Insider Threat Management and Analysis Center (DITMAC) has added the BTAC to effectively deliver a wider range of support, information, training, and consultation to the DoD Insider Threat Enterprise*

### DITMAC Behavioral Threat Analysis Center (BTAC)

The DITMAC/BTAC is a centralized capability that provides multidisciplinary Subject Matter Expertise (SME) in support of analysis and mitigation of potential insider threats. The BTAC Bulletin, a monthly publication, highlights emerging threats, trends, capabilities, and best practices to increase awareness across the DoD insider threat enterprise. Content will focus on training, reference material and other resources relevant to leaders and insider threat professionals.

**Behavioral Sciences:** The Behavioral Sciences team provides case consultation and mitigation strategies on cases with a behavioral science nexus. The SME's conduct research and create training products on behavioral indicators of concern, trends in behavioral science and insider threat, and mitigation strategies.

**Law Enforcement/Counterintelligence (LE/CI):** LE/CI SMEs offer valuable insights into the jurisdictional issues and methodologies used by local, state, and federal law enforcement and counterintelligence agencies. They aid in interpreting reports, pinpointing potential information sources, and contribute to the identification of mitigation strategies.

**Threat Assessment/Threat Management (TATM):** The TATM team focuses on patterns of thinking, behaviors, and actions of individuals who are, or pose, a significant insider threat risk to the DoD. TATM develops mitigation strategies to assist in preventing and reducing the associated risk.

**Cyber Security:** The Cyber Security function supports the Workforce Cybersecurity Training initiatives and provides Cybersecurity analysis and mitigation efforts to protect confidentiality, integrity, and availability of computer systems in the Department of Defense Insider Threat program.

### Employee Management Relations:

The HR team provides employee/management subject matter expertise to aid in the mitigation of potential risks associated with workplace violence, conduct, performance, attendance, and dispute resolution.
