The National Background Investigation Services (NBIS) is the federal government's integrated IT system for comprehensive personnel vetting — from case initiation to initial vetting, adjudication, and continuous vetting.

NBIS RELEASE 4.5.2 THE FUTURE OF PERSONNEL VETTING

The Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA) has successfully deployed Release 4.5.2 of NBIS. This deployment adds enhanced capabilities for subject management and case initiation. These features are part of an ongoing NBIS release rollout, ensuring that all functionalities receive appropriate user acceptance testing in a phased approach. The following features are part of NBIS Release 4.5.2:

SUBJECT MANAGEMENT

• State Bar: Extra Coverage code tab will include optional fields for Bar certification number, certification expiration date, and will require state of admission.

CASE INITIATION

- Secondary Requesting Official to AUB on Release: Provides up to 2 points of contact for background investigation case processing questions and concerns.
- Relaxing Contract Number Character Length for Single and Mass Initiation: Allows cleared industry to provide a full range of contract numbers.
- Updated Global Timers Initiation: The Initiation timer has been updated to 30 days to expiration.
- Updated Global Timers SFCompletion: An SFCompletion timer has been added with 90 days to expiration. In accordance with the new timer, new eApp statuses have been added, including Applicant Editing Form, Review Applicant Editing Form, Certified Pending Release, and Review Certified Pending Release.
