WHERE TO GO FOR NBIS TRAINING

All National Background Investigation Services (NBIS) training resources are accessible via Security Training, Education, and Professional Portal (STEPP). Visit STEPP for NBIS training materials including job aids, e-learnings, video shorts, learner paths, and registration for live webinars. Access to STEPP requires an account, and the site is now accessible via a more secure Smart Card Login. If you have not done so, please set up your account by following the prompts on the STEPP homepage by selecting Create New Account with DOD CAC or Non-DOD CAC.

Once logged into STEPP, navigate to the NBIS Training Homepage by selecting "Training" in the top left, and select "NBIS" from the drop-down list.

Tip: For ease of access to links within this newsletter, it's recommended to log into STEPP prior to selecting any of the links.

FINDING JOB AIDS & KNOWLEDGE ARTICLES IN STEPP WITH EASE

- 1. Log into STEPP and navigate to the **NBIS Training homepage**.
- 2. From the NBIS Training homepage, select NBIS Job Aids.
- 3. Select Expand All on the right side of the screen (this will open all the menus and make all job aids and knowledge articles visible).
- 4. Type CTRL+F on the keyboard (this will activate a search block in the top right corner of the page).
- 5. Enter the topic to learn more about (example: initiate, attachments, user roles, etc.).
- 6. All job aids and knowledge articles relevant to the searched topic will be highlighted on the page. Navigate down the page to see items with that topic name.

JOB AIDS AND KNOWLEDGE ARTICLES - ANNUAL REVIEW & REFRESH

Find all the job aids for NBIS end-users as well as organization management job aids for both Federal and Industry onboarding managers <u>here</u>.

As a reminder, NBIS is being developed iteratively, meaning the system is enhanced with each release. As a result, training materials may require updates if the enhancements cause changes to the user interface or current functionality. The NBIS Training Program has spent the last few weeks conducting a routine review and refresh of materials, ensuring all Job Aids and Knowledge Articles are up-to-date. Many are already available on STEPP, with more to be posted in the coming weeks. Check STEPP often for current versions as this effort continues!

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JOB AIDS AND KNOWLEDGE ARTICLES

On STEPP, you will find Job Aids and Knowledge Articles. What's the difference?

Job Aids are meant to show step-by-step actions — essentially a guide demonstrating how to perform the task(s). Knowledge Articles are more informational and provide more in-depth discussion to strengthen a user's understanding of a particular topic.

EARN CERTIFICATES FOR NBIS TRAINING

Following completion of a learner path or webinar, users can obtain a certificate to use to obtain Professional Development Units (PDUs) needed to maintain professional certifications obtained through CDSE.
