NEW & IMPROVED USER INTERFACE ON STEPP – IN PROGRESS

The NBIS Training Program has heard your feedback and is currently in the process of updating the user interface on STEPP for NBIS training. Once logged into STEPP, navigate to the NBIS Training Homepage by selecting "Training" in the top left, and select "NBIS" from the drop-down list.

Please be aware that some training products may have moved or may be found under updated menus. If you're unable to find something, please utilize the Search feature or drop us a line.

When logging into STEPP and visiting the NBIS Training page, you'll find links to onboarding materials to support Agencies and Industry with scaling and operationalizing. In addition, you'll see links to the Training Catalog and to NBIS job aids for all NBIS users.

Within the Onboard to NBIS materials, you will find video shorts, learner paths, job aids and knowledge articles, and industry tools.

Check out the NBIS Training Catalog to find eLearnings, video shorts, job aids and knowledge articles, microlearnings and podcasts, webinars, and learner paths.

The Job Aid and Knowledge Article pages have been sectioned into categories, such as Case Initiation, Subject Management, and Organization Management.

JOB AIDS AND KNOWLEDGE ARTICLES

REVIEW & REFRESH

The NBIS Training Program has spent the last several weeks conducting a routine review and refresh of materials, ensuring all Job Aids and Knowledge Articles are up-to-date. Many are already available on STEPP, with more to be posted in the coming weeks. Check STEPP often for current versions as this effort continues!

As a reminder, NBIS is being developed iteratively, meaning the system is enhanced with each release. As a result, training materials may require updates if the enhancements cause changes to the user interface or current functionality.

SEARCHING ON STEPP FOR JOB AIDS AND KNOWLEDGE ARTICLES

- 1. Navigate to the NBIS job aid page you are seeking: End User Training Catalog or **Onboarding Job Aids**
- 2. Select Expand All on the right side of the screen (this will open all the menus and make all job aids and knowledge articles visible).
- 3. Type CTRL+F on the keyboard (this will activate a search block in the top right corner
- 4. Enter the topic to learn more about (example: initiate, attachments, user roles, etc.).
- 5. All job aids and knowledge articles relevant to the searched topic will be highlighted on the page. Navigate down the page to see items with that topic name.

Wondering what user roles you have on your persona? While you can't edit your own roles, you can view them by selecting your initials at the top right side of the NBIS page once you are logged in.

FIND A LEARNER PATH

On STEPP, under the End-User Training, you will find various topic areas such as NBIS Overview & General Tasks, Subject Management, Adjudication Management, etc.

Under those main topic areas, you will find a link to Learner Paths. These learner paths provide a recommended series of courses to help the end-user navigate the training materials and ultimately be better prepared to navigate NBIS.

There are currently learner paths covering the following topics: Foundational, Case Initiation (one for Industry; another for Agency), Subject Management, and Adjudication.
