SEARCHING ON STEPP FOR JOB AIDS AND KNOWLEDGE ARTICLES

- 1. Navigate to the NBIS job aid page you are seeking: <u>End User Training</u> Catalog or Onboarding Job Aids.
- 2. Select **Expand All** on the right side of the screen (this will open all the menus and make all job aids and knowledge articles visible).
- 3. Type **CTRL+F** on the keyboard (this will activate a search block in the top right corner of the page).
- 4. Enter the topic to learn more about (example: initiate, attachments, user roles, etc.).
- All job aids and knowledge articles relevant to the searched topic will be highlighted on the page. Navigate down the page to see items with that topic name.



NBIS NUGGET WITH PROFESSOR NBIS

With the 4.6 release, NBIS now allows up to 20 alpha-numeric characters to be entered into the contract number field for single and mass initiation. The relaxing of contract numbers from 13 to 20 characters allows cleared industry to utilize a full range of contract numbers.
