DISS training can be accessed here via the NBIS Training Catalog on STEPP. You will find 12 eLearning modules, as well as Job Aids to support your use of DISS.



## SEARCHING ON STEPP FOR JOB AIDS AND KNOWLEDGE ARTICLES

- 1. Navigate to the NBIS job aid page you are seeking: <u>End User Training Catalog</u> or <u>Onboarding Job Aids.</u>
- 2. Select **Expand All** on the right side of the screen (this will open all the menus and make all job aids and knowledge articles visible).
- 3. Type **CTRL+F** on the keyboard (this will activate a search block in the top right corner of the page).
- 4. Enter the topic to learn more about (example: initiate, attachments, user roles, etc.).
- 5. All job aids and knowledge articles relevant to the searched topic will be highlighted on the page. Navigate down the page to see items with that topic name.

## NBIS NUGGET

NBIS allows up to 30 days within the Initiation phase for subjects to access their Standard Form in eApp from the time the case is initiated. Once they access the form, NBIS allows the subject up to 90 days to complete and certify the Standard Form.
