#### NBIS TRAINING HAS MOVED

Effective immediately, all National Background Investigation Services (NBIS) training resources have migrated from the former website, CounterMeasures, to STEPP.

#### **STEPP Login Instructions:**

Navigate to STEPP via the CDSE website at <a href="https://cdse.usalearning.gov/">https://cdse.usalearning.gov/</a>

1. Once logged in and on the homepage, users can go to the NBIS Dashboard, which can be accessed under the Training menu on the top left of the page.

NOTE: Users can also go directly to NBIS content via the Search Bar in the top right of the page.

2. Scroll down and select NBIS End-User Training to access NBIS training materials.

NBIS users can find training materials including job aids, knowledge articles, e-learnings, and video shorts.

Users can also register for interactive events, such as live webinars, on the STEPP website.
