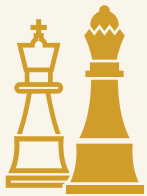
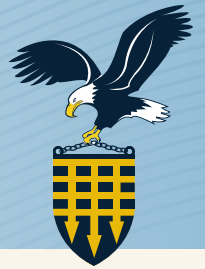


Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA)



Counterintelligence and Insider Threat (CI): *Preserving America's foundation of trust against foreign and insider threats*

Overview

The CI mission conducts activities to identify, assess, deter and mitigate foreign and insider threats to the U.S. government's industrial base and workforce in support of the agency's Industrial Security and Personnel Security missions — both directly and through collaborative engagement with other intelligence and law enforcement organizations. DCSA also oversees the DOD Insider Threat Management and Analysis Center (DITMAC) on the department's behalf.

DCSA's CI mission benefits from unique access to industry, building on its relationships across the industrial base.

- **Office of Counterintelligence:** provides the federal government's strongest link between the nation's industrial base, the U.S. CI and Intelligence Community and federal law enforcement. No other agency has the level of contact with industry that DCSA does. DCSA's industry partners identify and report threats firsthand. This enables DCSA to develop a comprehensive threat picture across cleared industry that is shared with industry and U.S. government leadership.
- The **Cyber Mission Center** leverages counterintelligence activities in cyberspace to identify, assess, exploit, degrade, counter and neutralize cyber threats to cleared industry, cleared personnel, DOD and DCSA.
- **DITMAC** provides the DOD enterprise the capability to detect and address risk from insiders; to oversee

and manage unauthorized disclosures; and to integrate, manage, mature and professionalize insider threat capabilities.

Through the goals outlined below, CI is continuing to prioritize collaboration and engagement with government and industry partners to effectively mitigate threats.
