### CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

Blake Moore is the Chief Operating Officer for the Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA) assuming the role on May 26, 2026.

In this role, Mr. Moore's responsibilities include translating the Director's priorities into disciplined execution across the enterprise, with a focus on alignment, operational effectiveness, accountability, customer outcomes, and mission delivery. The role supports execution of the Director's vision by strengthening coordination, improving operating rhythm, removing barriers, and ensuring the organization remains focused on priority objectives. His responsibilities also include

elevating key issues at the right time, reinforcing ownership and follow-through, and helping drive timely, effective decision-making across the agency.

Prior to joining DCSA, Mr. Moore served in senior government and private-sector leadership roles at the intersection of national security, intelligence, cybersecurity, cloud computing, and defense technology. Most recently, Mr. Moore served as Managing Director, Advanced Mission Platforms, at Anduril Industries, where he led strategy, growth, and partner efforts for advanced mission platforms supporting connected warfare, tactical edge computing, and mission operations in contested environments.

Before joining Anduril, Mr. Moore served at Amazon Web Services, where he drove strategic execution as the Chief Strategy Officer for the Department of War business, while supporting cloud modernization, cybersecurity, and mission technology adoption across the defense enterprise. His private-sector experience also includes leadership roles at Wickr communications as the VP of Strategy and Operations and Splunk as the Senior Director of Operations, where he helped bring commercial technology capabilities into federal and national security mission environments.

Mr. Moore previously served in the Office of the Department of Defense (DoD) Chief Information Officer as Chief of Staff, where he helped drive enterprise information technology and cyber resilience within the digital modernization portfolio. In that role, he supported strategic planning, operational execution, interagency coordination, and senior-level decision-making on issues including cloud adoption, cybersecurity, data, and command and control. His DoD service also included work leading the 2018 DoD Cyber Strategy and the Department's first Cyber Posture Review.

Earlier in his career, Mr. Moore served in national security and intelligence roles at U.S. Cyber Command as the first Deputy J2 for the Cyber National Mission Force and the Chief Operating Officer for the Joint Intelligence Operations Center, the Defense Intelligence Agency, the National Security Agency, and the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Cyber Policy. He began his public service in the U.S. Air Force as a digital network intelligence analyst and deployed to Afghanistan in support of combat operations.

Throughout his career, Mr. Moore has focused on leading complex transformation efforts across government and industry, with an emphasis on operational turnaround, technology modernization, mission execution, and building trusted teams across public-private boundaries.

Mr. Moore holds a Master of Science in Intelligence Analysis from Johns Hopkins University and a Bachelor of Arts in Intelligence Studies. He has also completed executive and professional education through Cornell University and Syracuse University in leadership, cyber policy, and national security.
