#### **Subject: Final FY 2024 Investigations Reimbursable Billing Rates**

Federal Investigations Notice (FIN) 22-01 dated June 30, 2022, published DCSA's initial, planned rates for FY 2024, which included planned rates for new Trusted Workforce (TW) 2.0 Initial Vetting and Continuous Vetting (CV) products and services. FIN 22-01 enabled DCSA customers to begin budgeting and planning their resource requirements for FY 2024, while also notifying customers that final prices for FY 2024 were planned to be released in December 2022. This FIN announces the final FY 2024 prices.

Since June 2022, DCSA has collaborated with the Security Clearance, Suitability/Fitness, and Credentialing community to evaluate policy, operational, and inflationary impacts on future personnel security costs. As a result of this thorough evaluation, followed by DoD Comptroller review and approval, DCSA is lowering FY 2024 rates for tiered BI products by 18 percent and retaining all other product and service rates published in FIN 22-01. The 18 percent rate reduction is applied to new TW 2.0 tiered BI products as well as legacy tiered BI products in the event legacy products are still necessary for customers to order in FY 2024.

By providing this significant rate reduction, DCSA will lessen the overall personnel vetting cost impacts to customers in FY 2024 as we continue to implement the full scope of TW 2.0 policies and procedures, specifically CV. As is done each year, DCSA will reassess costs and workload and will adjust rates accordingly in FY 2025 and beyond to ensure full-cost recovery. The 18 percent reduction in this FIN is not expected to be continued in the future. Accordingly, we recommend that customers maintain their planned personnel vetting budgets through FY 2025 and beyond to be appropriately positioned for future year rate updates. #### **Ordering and Invoicing**

- Customers will need to leverage an existing interagency agreement or establish a new interagency agreement with DCSA in order to be invoiced.
  - Initial Vetting products and service will require a separate interagency agreement from other DCSA products and services.
  - Case requests may be accepted and processed prior to the completion of the interagency agreement and pending the availability of funds. DCSA maintains the authority to decline new case requests and/or suspend work if interagency agreements are not received and funded in a timely manner.
- Requestors are responsible for providing the required financial information needed for DCSA to apply the case request to a funded agreement. Requests that have invalid or missing information will be rejected or flagged for further action.
- Customers will be billed monthly based on the number of case requests received in the prior month and adjustments made to any prior case requests.
- Invoices will be separate from the invoices issued for other DCSA products and services.

- Customers will need to leverage an existing interagency agreement or establish a new interagency agreement with DCSA prior to enrolling subjects into a TW Service.
- Customers will be billed the monthly subscription fee per each enrollee that was active at any point in the prior month.
- No refunds or adjustments will be provided for partial month enrollment.
- Invoices will be separate from the invoices issued for other DCSA products and services.

#### **Ordering and Invoicing**

- Customers will need to leverage an existing interagency agreement or establish a new interagency agreement with DCSA prior to ordering ESP products and being invoiced.
  - Exception: To meet ESP policies established within the DoD, an ESP check will be automatically conducted on DoD submissions if a foreign nexus is establish during the review of the subject's SF 86 or otherwise developed. Subsequently, DoD customers will be charged for an ESP Standard check when this occurs. ESP checks may be conducted prior to the completion of the interagency agreement and pending the availability of funds. DCSA maintains the authority to decline new case requests and/or suspend work if interagency agreements are not received and funded in a timely manner.
- Customers will be billed monthly for each ESP product that was completed in the prior month.
- Invoices will be separate from the invoices issued for other DCSA products and services.
