

OPIS	The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) Personnel Investigations Processing System (PIPS) Imaging System (OPIS) provides electronic storage and retrieval for all DCSA conducted background investigations and related case material.
PIPS	The Personnel Investigations Processing System (PIPS) manages case ingest beginning with e-APP/e-QIP applications through scheduling, closure, and agency delivery. The PIPS houses the Security and Suitability Investigations Index (SII), indexing over 20 million background investigations.
ARC-Nlets	Automated Records Check (ARC-Nlets) system interfaces with the International Justice and Public Safety Network (Nlets). This interface support the automated processing of state-wide law checks, required in the background investigation process.
DMRS	Dashboard Management Reporting System (DMRS) is a web-based application that supports performance analytics, performance data management, and agency reporting (ie, Key Performance Indicators (KPI)).
FWS	The Field Work System (FWS) interfaces with PIPs; FWS provides the investigative field workforce a capability to view assigned tasks, ability to view/send investigative case messages, assign case items, and write reports of investigations (ROIs).
NFW	The Non Field Work (NFW) system supports data exchanges between Personnel Investigations Processing System (PIPS) and established data providers for the processing of NACs (National Agency Checks), required in the background investigation process.
NP2	The New Public Portal (NP2) provides DCSA customers a capability for secure communication, access e-QIP, PIPS/CVS, and libraries of investigative notices and other key information.
