DCSA ANNOUNCES FY23 INVESTIGATIVE SERVICES PRICING

Agency's Federal Investigation Notice Marks Third Consecutive Price Reduction

QUANTICO, Va. – The Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency announced the FY23 pricing for investigative products and services in a federal investigations notice (FIN) released today. The notice also highlighted initial estimated FY24 prices.

Today's release marks the third price reduction since DCSA became the federal government's largest investigative service provider (ISP) in 2019. In that role, DCSA delivers investigative products to more than 105 federal agencies and charges for those services on a reimbursable basis via the agency's working capital fund.

"DCSA is helping our customers by standardizing pricing to support predictability in annual and long-range customer agency budgeting, and simplify the DCSA billing process," said DCSA Director William K. Lietzau. "Our efforts to reform our pricing processes while implementing major change to enterprise-wide personnel vetting is paying off not only in higher quality vetting, but in cost savings for customers across government."

For FY23, DCSA is lowering prices for the following products and services:

- Reducing background investigation prices, investigation tiers 1 through 5, by 5% compared to previously published rates.
- Reducing service subscription fees for Trusted Workforce (TW) 1.5 continuous vetting (CV) service for non-DOD agencies by 23% compared to previously published rates.

For FY24, DCSA is introducing new products and services to support implementation of Trusted Workforce 2.0, the federal government's personnel vetting reform policy. These products include initial vetting products as well as TW 2.0 CV service for both DOD and non-DOD customers requiring background investigations for national security positions.

FY24 TW 2.0 prices are estimates published to support FY24 agency budget development. DCSA expects to publish final FY24 prices in December 2022.
