



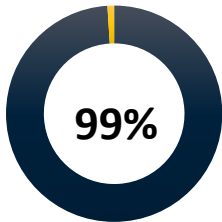

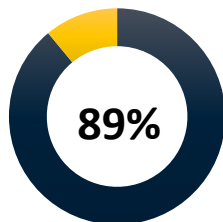
FY20 BY THE NUMBERS

In FY20, over 650 DOD CAF employees and contractors conducted 1.1 million personnel security, suitability, and credentialing actions for all three branches of government.

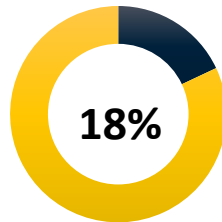
National Security Eligibility for DOD

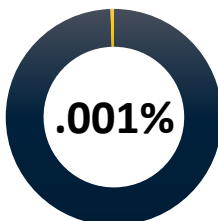

Denied or Revoked



In FY20, the DoD CAF denied or revoked **1,198** security clearances. These cases predominantly fell under the following national security adjudicative guidelines: *Personal Conduct, Financial Considerations, Criminal Conduct, Drug Involvement and Substance Misuse, and Alcohol Consumption.*
