Subject: FY 2021 Investigations Reimbursable Billing Rates Effective October 1, 2020

The National Background Investigations Bureau (NBIB), in coordination with the Department of Defense (DoD) Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA), plans to make no change to reimbursable billing rates in FY 2021. Prices for our products and services will remain the same as our FY 2020 rates (see FIN 18-04, FY 2020 Investigations Reimbursable Billing Rates Effective October 1, 2019). We encourage our customers to use this notice as a primary reference for their FY 2021 personnel security investigation budget.

Please note that starting in FY 2020 with NBIB transitioning to DCSA, background investigation product and service rates will be under the purview of DoD. DCSA plans to take all necessary steps to keep current effective rates unchanged throughout FY 2020 and FY 2021. Throughout FY 2020, as new policies are finalized, our future workload becomes more defined, and our future costs become better known, if any rate changes are required, DCSA will provide our customers sufficient advanced notice.

We appreciate the engagement of all our stakeholders and look forward to working with you throughout the transition period to ensure the most effective, efficient and high-quality background investigation program continues to support the federal government enterprise.
